INSURANCE INFO

Once again there are questions about the insurance required to participate at the Sterling Hill Super Dig.

1. You will be covered if you are a member of a Federation affiliated club AND that club has insurance that covers its members when on club functions and activities AND if that club has drawn a resolution deeming the Sterling Hill Super Dig to be an 'official' activity of the club.

2. If the above does not cover your situation, then you must show proof at registration that you have personal accident and liability insurance that will cover you at the Sterling Hill Super Dig and releases the Delaware Valley Earth Science Society, Inc., its officers, trustees, and members, and the owners, leasees, and operators and any other co-sponsors and volunteers from any and all liability due to injury, fatal or otherwise, or property loss, personal or otherwise, incurred during the sponsored field trip to the Sterling Hill Dig, Franklin, NJ. In addition, all participants must sign a "waiver and release from liability" at check-in.

3. If neither of the above covers your situation, you can simply join the Delaware Valley Earth Science Society (DVESS) as a member (at the registration table) and so be covered by their group insurance policy.
